LIMITED LIFETIME WARRANTY

Thank you for purchasing your aluminum fence. To activate this Manufacturer's Limited Lifetime Warranty (Warranty), complete and return the Warranty Registration Card to Country Estate Fence, Inc. (CEF) within 30 days from the date of completed installation.

Warranty Protection – This Warranty pertains only to (i) the Original Consumer Purchaser who purchases the warranted products for approved residential uses or applications and is transferable to a Subsequent Consumer Purchaser as noted herein (ii) the Original Commercial Purchaser who purchases the warranted products for approved commercial uses or applications. This Warranty is not transferable to a Subsequent Commercial Purchaser or for commercial uses or applications.

Limited Lifetime Warranty Coverage – For Fence and Rail Products (excluding fence hardware), this Warranty covers the following, subject to the limitations noted herein:

- (a) Defects in material and workmanship.
- (b) Abnormal cracking, peeling or chipping.
- (c) Abnormal weathering or fading.

Exclusive Remedy – Under this Warranty, the Exclusive Remedy for breach of this Warranty is limited to the repair or replacement of the defective material by the Manufacturer. Reimbursement of the cost of removal and/or reinstallation is not covered and the Manufacturer will not provide such services.

UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED UNDER APPLICABLE LOCAL OR PROVINCIAL LAW, THE MANUFACTURER IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, LOST PROFITS OR LOSS OF USE DAMAGES. THESE EXCLUSIONS APPLY EVEN IF THE MANUFACTURER HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF THESE DAMAGES, AND EVEN IF THE LIMITED REMEDY FAILS OF ITS ESSENTIAL PURPOSE. TO THE EXTENT THAT UNDER APPLICABLE LOCAL OR PROVINCIAL LAW YOU HAVE ANY BASIS FOR A REMEDY BEYOND THIS LIMITED REMEDY, THEN THE MANUFACTURER'S LIABILITY TO YOU CAN BE NO MORE THAN THE PURCHASE PRICE FOR THE PRODUCTS.

Warranty Claim Procedure – If the material appears to have a defect, the Original Consumer Purchaser must advise your fence installer and CEF. To file a claim made against this Warranty, the Consumer Purchaser must submit to CEF photographs of the material in question, a copy of the Installation Agreement between you and the installer, a written summary of the issue and other such information that may be requested to resolve a Warranty claim. If a determination or resolution cannot be reached using the submitted material, CEF will dispatch, at its expense, a company representative to inspect the product.

Exclusive Warranty/Disclaimer of Implied Warranties/Limitation of Damages.

This Warranty constitutes the complete Warranty by the Manufacturer and is given in lieu of all other warranties, expressed or implied.

THE MANUFACTURER DISCLAIMS ALL IMPLIED WARRANTIES, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.

If local, state, or provincial law gives you an implied warranty, notwithstanding the disclaimer in the previous sentence, the duration of that warranty will be the same time period as the express warranties set forth herein, unless state, local or provincial law does not allow limitations on the duration of an implied warranty. This Warranty may not be modified, amended or supplemented without written approval of the Manufacturer. No other agreement, written or implied, is valid. The Manufacturer does not authorize any other person or agent, including the installer and CEF, to make any other expressed or implied warranties.

Transfer – A Consumer Purchaser who purchases warranted products for approved applications are eligible for a one-time transfer of the Warranty to a Subsequent Consumer Purchaser of the real estate on which the warranted products were originally installed if (1) The Warranty to be transferred was properly registered by the Original Consumer Purchaser with CEF/Manufacturer within 30 days after the original date of completed installation. (2) The request for transfer is made within 10 years of the original date of completed installation. (3) The warranted products have not been moved from the original location and/or altered from the approved design or intended use, or modified in a manner that compromises the product’s original integrity. (4) The Manufacturer receives a written request for transfer within 30 days of the real estate transfer. (5) The Manufacturer receives proof of the original purchase and receives a copy of the original Warranty. The Warranty for commercial and industrial applications is not transferable, unless commercial and industrial materials are used in a residential application.

Exclusions – The following defects are excluded from this Warranty: (a) those caused by marine, salty, or harsh environmental conditions, including normal fading (as determined by Delta E color measurement, not to exceed Delta 5); (b) those caused by acts of God; (c) those arising from improper installation; (d) those arising from unauthorized use or alterations of the product; (e) those caused by negligence, abuse, accident; (f) those arising from the failure to provide periodic maintenance in a manner consistent with traditional maintenance of similar aluminum products (upon request, CEF will provide required Care & Maintenance information from the Manufacturer); (g) appearance associated with normal weathering or fading from exposure to sunlight; (h) oxidation caused by airborne chemicals or air pollution; (i) exposure to or application of paint, varnish, chemicals (including lawn care chemicals or cleaning agents not approved by the Manufacturer); (j) any materials (including gate hardware) that are not produced or supplied by the Manufacturer.
